



50+ Programme

08 – 22 May & 04 – 18 September 2010



This programme combines a course of English lessons in the morning with a selection of afternoon and evening activities designed to appeal to mature adult students who want to enjoy Jersey's tourist attractions and beautiful scenery in the company of other people of the same age-group.

Jersey is a small British island just off the coast of France. It is popular with the senior British tourist market for its miles of clean, sandy beaches and green countryside. Thanks to the Gulf Stream, its mild climate makes it an attractive destination in spring and autumn for tourists who want to explore the beautiful landscape. St Helier, the capital town, is full of high quality shops and restaurants, offering good food from all over the world – as well, of course, as the local fish.



Lessons take place each morning from 9 am until 12.30 pm in small classes (8 maximum) at our large school located 200m from the picturesque harbour village of St Aubin.

For a real experience of British life, students can choose to stay with a specially selected local host-family who provides breakfast, a packed lunch and dinner with the family. Our school bus collects students in the morning and takes them back to their families after school and the host-family arranges transfers to and from the airport or harbour.

Alternatively, students can choose from one of many guest houses and hotels in St Aubin, where there is also a wide choice of excellent restaurants and pubs which provide evening meals.

The activity and social programme includes coastal and country walks, excursions to Jersey's main historical sites and social evenings where students can get to know each other better (and practise their English) in a relaxed environment. There is also an optional weekend day trip to France.
